Stellate ganglion PRF, trigeminal RF, sphenopalatine RF, cervical cooled/RF, cervical DRG blocks/PRF, lumbar cooled/RF, lumbar DRG blocks/PRF, splanchnic RF, lumbar sympathetic RF, sacroiliac joint cooled/bipolar RF, thoracic cooled/RF, thoracic DRG blocks/PRF, thoracic sympathetic RF, discography, disc biacuplasty, disc decompression, hip & knee joint cooled RF (additional procedures may also be covered)
